## NOTES

1. Data for FFM and most SPMs is reported in above links to the May 1 ASPE Issue Brief. Data from SBMs is pulled from various press statements and resources released by the Exchanges. Updated information may be available.
2. The HHS ASPE reports with FFM data include total numbers of plan selections and do not represent effectuated enrollment of those who have paid premium. Some SBM reports may include such effectuated enrollment data and if so, are included within this chart. Refer to sources for more information.
3. In 2014, most health insurance marketplaces offered medical policies known as Qualified Health Plans (QHPs), QHPs that embedded pediatric dental benefits, and separate Qualified Dental Plans (QDPs, also known as Stand-Alone Dental Plans) which were available as an additional, voluntary purchase. There are a few exceptions including, as examples, the state-based Connecticut marketplace that did not offer enrollment in QDPs due to technical difficulties and Kentucky, Nevada and Washington marketplaces that required the purchase of pediatric dental benefits when covering children.
